
Island natives see first flying saucer

DARWIN: Natives living at Garden Point mission, Melville Island, near the northernmost tip of Australia, have reported a flying saucer.

An unidentified object travelling at tremendous speed was seen in the sky at daylight over Shark Bay, Melville Island, a few days ago.

Natives called out to Bro. G. Clark, superintendent of the mission, who also saw the object.

The saucer, in level flight and trailing flame and smoke, disappeared northward.

Bro. Clark has reported the sighting to naval intelligence. The natives had not previously heard of a flying saucer.
