

## "FLYING SAUCER" SEEN AT WARWICK

WARWICK, June 17.— Four railway fitters claim that they saw "an oval-shaped object, coloured like a cloud, with stubby wings and a tail," high in the sky to-day. Ganger F. Leo, of Ellithorpe, (about 110 miles from Brisbane on the main southern line) who with Messrs. J. Coleman, C. Dixon and E. Sutherland, was working on the Troncoomba-Warwick permanent way between Ellithorpe and Elphinstone, said that the object was in sight for about five minutes and gave off an intense white light. All four of them saw the object flying slowly east in the north-east sky. While watching it, it picked up speed and was travelling extremely fast when it disappeared in a northerly direction. Mr. Leo said afterwards: "I'm not in the habit of seeing things. I honestly believe we saw some strange aircraft."
