

Stubby Winged Object In Sky

WARWICK, June 17.—Four railway fitters claim they saw "an oval-shaped object coloured like a cloud with stubby wings and tail" high in the sky to-day.

The ganger, Mr. E. Leo, of Ellinthorpe (about 140 miles from Brisbane on the main southern line), who, with Messrs L. Coleman, C. Dixon,

and E. Sanderson, was working on the Toowoomba—Warwick permanent way between Ellinthorpe and Elphinstone, said the object was in sight for about five minutes, and gave off an intense white light.

All four of them saw the object flying slowly east in the north-east sky. While

watching it, it picked up speed and was travelling extremely fast when it disappeared in a northerly direction.

Mr. Leo said afterwards, "I'm not in the habit of seeing things. I honestly believe we saw some strange aircraft."
