

FLYING SAUCER TAKES DOUBLE AT ARRILALAH

Winning the Rosabel Handicap and the Arrilalah Trophy on Saturday in convincing style Flying Saucer proved that she is a force to be reckoned with, and should do well in the Back to Longreach meeting next month.

Bred by Mr. E. Cochrane, and raced in his daughter's (Mrs. A. Ferguson) name, "Saucer" was popular with the punters and went out well backed in both races: that she was penalised 7lbs. in the Trophy appeared to make little difference to her magnificent run.

The meeting was entirely successful and attracted a good crowd, though not of record proportions. Much work has been put into the track and its appointments, but a readable starters' and riders' board would be greatly appreciated.

Five bookmakers fielded and the tote attracted good business, highest dividend of the day being 32/ on Perfect Star in the first race.

The Ladies' Committee handled the catering arrangements very satisfactorily.

AS THEY RAN

Windue led for the early portion of the Trophy and the "Saucer" was running second at the turn but came away to lead the field by 2 lengths.

In the first race, the Booloo Maiden, Synotime appeared to have the race well in hand but

have the race well in hand but went wide and finished well off the track and Perfect Star came out of the bunch in the last stages to go out to win by half a length from Little John, and St. Silent was a length behind.

The Belmore looked like being anybody's race at the turn but Darcy Duggan added another win to the Cochrane family by coming out in the straight and finished two lengths ahead of Miss Neon, and Gold Spray was only half a head away. These two were locked together for the greater portion of the run down the straight.

The Westfield was never in doubt, it was Bush Lawyer's race from start to finish and he went past the judge 8 lengths away

from Pic Dear with False Sound another four lengths away.

Gold Spray made no error about winning the last race of the day, the Whitehill Hack Handicap. Getting away well Gold Spray stayed in front for practically the whole of the journey and finished 4 lengths in front of Miss Neon with False Sound two lengths further back.
