

BARBER STAGES HOAX

SHAVED MONKEY WINS BET

"LITTLE MAN FROM FLYING SAUCER"

ATLANTA July 9 (A.A.P.).

—A barber said to-day he shaved a dead monkey and passed it off as "a visitor from outer space" to win a 10 dollar bet that he could not get his photograph in the papers.

The monkey cost him 50 dollars and a judge fined him 40 dollars to-day for obstructing a main road by staging a fake incident designed to support his story.

The man, Edward Watters (28), was arrested on a warrant charging cruelty to animals. The charge was dismissed when the police found the monkey had been killed in another county.

Watters told the police he killed the animal, shaved it and claimed the body was "a little man from a flying saucer." On his confession, two companions held with him were freed.
