

Details of "saucers" wanted

MELBOURNE, Sat.—
Australia's Flying Saucer Investigation Committee will ask Batlow (N.S.W.) residents for more details about "flying saucers" seen over the town.

The committee, which includes four members of the Astronomical Society of Victoria, thinks that natural phenomena, such as fireballs, could not account for the Batlow reports.

A Batlow resident's account of "saucers" was read at a meeting of the committee in Melbourne last night.

The committee would not disclose the name of the observer.

The Batlow report said that seven times between May 18 and July 6 balloon-like, luminous spinning objects had been seen high in the sky.

The objects were glowing red and spinning as they moved backwards and forwards at a high speed.
