

"Flying Saucer" At Warwick

WARWICK, July 23.—

For about half an hour this afternoon a number of residents gazed skywards, watching a mystery object moving slowly around at high altitude.

Among the first to see it were Mr. and Mrs. J. Windle, from their nursery at the northern end of Guy Street.

Mrs. Windle said tonight that her attention was first drawn to it about 3 p.m. It resembled a long white streak in the west at great height, and moving slowly it appeared at first to be a plane on fire. However, this idea was dispelled as it continued to move slowly south.

Suddenly it moved almost vertically upward and turned and came straight down, seemingly to flatten out. Then it moved slowly across the city to the north-north-east, where it performed an evolution resembling a plane doing a slow motion somersault.

It appeared to flatten out again, and when last seen about 3.30 p.m., was moving eastward.
