

SUBURBS SEE FLYING SAUCER

SYDNEY, Monday.

Several people reported they had seen a "flying saucer" over Villawood about 9.15 last night.

One man, Mr George Douglas, of Koonoona Avenue, Villawood, said he was talking to a neighbour, Mr. Max Garland, when he saw the object.

"It was up about 15,000 feet and travelling very fast," he said.

"A blue flame was coming from the back of it, and a couple of white lights were showing."

"Shot Away"

Mr. Garland said: "The object circled for a while, then shot away.

"A couple of minutes later, Mr. Douglas and I saw it again."

Mascot aerodrome said last night that no planes were over Villawood at that time. A spokesman for the Weather Bureau said no balloons were up last night.
