

# Visitors From Space ?

In the past few years reports of unidentified objects in the sky have been coming in at the rate of one a month.

From Bangkok and Switzerland, South America and India, Africa and the United States, comes evidence which adds up to the greatest mystery of the age.

Consider the case of the cigar-shaped object seen over New Delhi recently. Thousands of dwellers in the city were startled by a strange machine in the sky which seemed to be circling over them.

A British witness described it as "a bullet-nosed object about 100 feet long, with a ring of flames at the end." It was followed by a thick white streak.

The machine travelled soundlessly and appeared to

soundlessly, and appeared to reach a maximum speed of 2,000 miles an hour.

Two jet fighters of the Indian Air Force were sent up to investigate, but the object eluded them. It climbed swiftly to about 20,000 feet, then vanished.

That same night the object was seen over Allahabad, 400 miles away, and a fortnight afterwards it was again reported over Delhi. As on its first visit the machine travelled at about 5,000 feet and was in sight for twenty minutes.

Then it climbed at high speed and at an angle of about eighty degrees. Again it left a thick white streak that remained visible for ninety minutes.

**From the battlefield of Korea comes another inexplicable report. The crew of a bomber returning from a night mission were flying over Wonsan, on the north coast, when a strong object was spotted in the sky.**

**It was a spinning disc-shaped machine, orange in color, and with small blue flames playing about the rim.**

**For five minutes the disc kept pace with the bomber, then suddenly it vanished.**

### **DETAILED DESCRIPTION**

**Two men inside the bomber—both of them experienced flyers—saw the object and**

ced flyers—saw the object and described it in detail.

On the same evening another bomber from the squadron had been over Suncheon, about eighty miles from Wonsan. Two members of its crew also saw a revolving globe, which followed them for about a minute.

If you are still unconvinced, consider the stories that have recently come from the United States. A series of eight bright green objects, described as "fireballs" were witnessed by hundreds of people as far apart as New Mexico, Texas and Oklahoma.

Science can offer us no explanation. Perhaps, before long, something more will happen to give us a clue about this riddle of the skies.
