

Flying Saucer Radio Show Panicked By "Space Man"

NEW YORK, Wed. (A.A.P.): A telephone caller claiming to be "from outer space," interrupted a local radio show this morning and caused hundreds of listeners—some in a panic—to phone the studio.

Jinx Falkenburg and husband Tex McCrary, popular radio couple, were interviewing Major Donald Kehoe about his new book, "Flying Saucers From Outer Space," when the call came through.

Miss Falkenburg answer-

ed, but became too hysterical to talk with the caller. She turned the call over to her husband, who inadvertently held the phone close to the microphone.

Listeners heard a thickly-accented voice saying, "This is a voice from outer

space. I warn you earthmen to stop talking about flying saucers, about bombs and preparations for war, for unless you learn to live in peace your planet will be annihilated."
