

Plane to Fly at 1500 m.p.h.

. New York, Monday: Canada's planned "flying saucer" fighter: was intended to fly at 1500 m.p.h., the "New York Times" said.

Research men at the big A. V. Roe aircraft factory outside Toronto had been working on the "flying saucer" for two years.

Until six months ago the project had been one of Canada's most closely guarded secrets, but since then stray facts had begun to leak out and had been fitted together by aviation reporters.

"The Times" said it was reported that paper work on the revolutionary gyroscopic disc fighter had gone as far as it could go.

What was needed now was money to build the prototype. Estimated cost of a pilot model was at least 200 million dollars (£89,300,000).
