

## "Flying Saucer" Test In U.S.

NEW YORK, November 13. The Canadian Transport Department has set up a laboratory designed to test the truth of "flying saucer" reports.

The engineer in charge of the broadcast section of the department, Mr. W. B. Smith, said that while there is no proof that flying saucers exist, there is a high degree of probability that they do exist and that they come from another planet.

"If they are interplanetary, they must work on some technology which has something in common with our own basic physics," he said. "If that is so our equipment will be able to detect them, even though the experiment is a shot in the dark."

The laboratory, which will be ready in a few days, is at Shirley's Bay, 10 miles north-west of Ottawa, alongside the department's ionospheric observatory.
