


Whitehall on "saucers"

LONDON, Wed. — What could have been a flying saucer — if there are flying saucers — has prompted reports from the War Office and the Air Ministry.

The War Office report said an anti-aircraft unit in south-east London on November 3 picked up a "signal" on its radar screen and followed the track of "an object" which appeared "circular or spherical in shape and white in color." It added that an object was also seen through a telescope by men of the same unit on the same day.

The Air Ministry said all reports of possible "saucers" were investigated, but in 95 per cent. of cases they were either meteorites or the reflection of sunlight or moonlight on aircraft. "But in the remaining cases there was no explanation. There is no conclusive evidence for saying flying saucers do, or do not exist."
