
"FLYING SAUCER" SEEN

OVER SOUTH-EAST LONDON

LONDON, Nov. 19 (A.A.P.).

—The British War Office today officially recognised the Flying Saucer. A War Office report said that an anti-aircraft unit in South-east London on November 8, picked up a signal on its radar screen.

The unit followed the track of the "object," which appeared "circular or spherical and white in colour." The War Office said the object was also seen through a telescope by men of the same unit on the same day.

The Air Ministry said tonight that all reports of possible "saucers" were investigated, but in 85 per cent. of the cases there was a natural explanation. They were either meteorites or reflections of sunlight or moonlight on aircraft. It added: "However, in the remaining cases there was no explanation. There is no conclusive evidence for saying that flying saucers do or do not exist."
