

FLYING SAUCER "RECOGNISED"

LONDON, Thursday: Britain's War Office has officially recognised the flying saucer.

A War Office report says that an anti aircraft unit in South-East London on November 3 picked up a signal on its radar screen and followed the track of an "object" which appeared to be "Circular or spherical and white in color."

The object also was seen through a telescope by men of the same unit the same day.

The Air Ministry said all reports of possible "saucers" were investigated by in 95 per cent of cases there was a natural explanation—there were either meteorites or reflections of sunlight and moonlight on aircraft.

Admitting that there is no explanation of the remaining cases, the Ministry said "There is no conclusive evidence for saying that flying saucers do or do not exist."
