

"FLYING SAUCER" NOW RECOGNISED BY WAR OFFICE

LONDON, Nov. 19. — The British War Office today officially recognised the flying saucer.

The War Office report said an anti-aircraft unit in South-east London on November 3 picked up a signal on its radar screen unit and followed the track of the "object" which appeared "circular or spherical and white in colour."

The War Office said the object also was seen through a telescope by men of the same unit the same day

The Air Ministry said tonight that all reports of possible "saucers" were investigated, but in 95 per cent of the cases there was a natural explanation.

They were either meteorites or reflections of sunlight or moonlight on aircraft. It added, "but in the remaining cases there was no explanation. There is no conclusive evidence for saying that 'flying saucers' do, or do not exist."
