

"Flying Saucer" Recognized

LONDON, Friday. — The British War Office has officially recognized the flying saucer.

The War Office report said an anti-aircraft unit in south east London on November 3 picked up a signal on its radar screen unit followed the track of the "object" which appeared "circular or spherical white in color."

The object was also seen through a telescope by men

of the same unit on the same day.

The Air Ministry said all reports of possible "saucers" were investigated, but in 95 per cent of the cases there was a natural explanation. They were either meteorites or reflections of sunlight or moonlight on aircraft, it added.

"But in the remaining cases there was no explanation. There is no conclusive evidence for saying that flying saucers do or don't exist," the War Office report concluded.
