

FLYING SAUCER THEORY

COMMONS QUERY

LONDON, Sunday: Flying saucers which were reported sighted from four western capitals recently could be reconnaissance patrols from another planet, according to theories worked out by experts.

Leading US investigator of saucers (Major Keyhoe) said recently that people of earth who wanted to observe another planet believed to be inhabited would send up a "mother space ship" from which small patrol craft would be launched.

If attacked by fighter planes from another world they would zoom away out of danger, just as saucers picked up on London's anti-aircraft radar set on November 3 behaved, he stated today.

Earthmen who wanted to explore Mars would set up bases on the moons which circle Mars. It may well be that men from Mars may equally well have established bases on earth's moon. Flying saucer reports always come when Mars reaches closest point to earth in its orbit.

The Air Ministry has dismissed 95 per cent of saucer reports as explainable by natural phenomena. However, three members of parliament have given notice of questions in the Commons this week regarding the remaining 5 per cent.

Canada, United States and South Africa have investigated reports of flying saucers, and Canada has built an official "saucer spotting base."

Dr. R. H. Stoy, Royal astronomer at Capetown, said "there is some sort of phenomena not yet adequately explained."
