

# Identified Saucers As Balloons

**LONDON (A.A.P.). —** The monthly journal "The Aeroplane" is satisfied that "unidentified objects in the general category of flying saucer" sighted over England recently were balloons.

There seems little doubt it said on Friday, that the object picked up on the radar set of a London anti-aircraft unit about a month ago and "quite possibly several others recently reported," was one of the non-extensible balloons now being used in America for the collection of upper air data.
