

## **“FLYING SAUCER” PILOT REPORTS**

An Australian National Airways pilot, Captain D. Barker, believes he saw a “flying saucer” at 10.15 a.m. today, not far from Melbourne.

Captain Barker, who was at his home at East Doncaster, said he saw a semi-transparent object with a top shaped roughly like a dish, about 2000 ft. above the Yarra Valley, in the direction of Templestowe.

He estimated that the flying object was 2 to 2½ miles away, and said it looked about four times the size of a DC4 plane at that distance.

“It was travelling at high speed,” he said, “and seemed to be oscillating in and out of clouds.”

Captain Barker said he reported this to the Civil Aviation officer at Essendon.

He then rang The Herald to see whether anyone else had reported the object. The Herald had no other reports.
