

Saucer Over Essendon, Pilot Claims

MELBOURNE, Friday. — An A.N.A. pilot reported today that he had seen a flying saucer—an object “semi-transparent and shaped like a dish.”

The pilot, Captain D. Barker, saw the object while at his home in East Doncaster this morning.

He told the Civil Aviation Officer at Essendon it was flying at about 2000 feet and appeared to be going in and out of clouds.

He estimated the object was about 2 miles away when he saw it.

At that distance it appeared about four times the size of a DC4 plane.
