

Flying Saucer, Pilot Claims

MELBOURNE, Friday.

While at his home at East Doncaster this morning, Captain D. Barker, an A.N.A. pilot, saw what he believed to be a flying saucer, and reported to the civil aviation officer at Essendon.

Captain Barker said that the object appeared to be semi-transparent and shaped like a dish. It was flying at about 2,000 feet, and appeared to be flying in and out of clouds.

He estimated that the object was about 2½ miles away when he saw it, and said that at that distance it appeared to be about four times the size of a DC4 aircraft.
