

## Saucer Report for Scrutiny

The Flying Saucer Investigation Committee, a private organisation, will make a full study of reports from the A.N.A. pilot, Captain Douglas Barker, that he saw a "flying saucer" on Friday.

The chairman of the committee (Mr. D. K. Thomson) said yesterday that reports of "flying saucers" could not be easily dismissed.

Captain Barker was an experienced pilot, and would not be likely to make a mistake. Several other pilots had also reported seeing "flying saucers."

In the six months since its formation the committee had received 20 reports of "flying saucers" over Victoria, including six from Melbourne.
