

30 "Saucers" Dived at Her

Miss I. M. Lutze, of Caulfield, who claims she saw 30 "flying saucers" near Ballarat on October 7, 1952, did not report them until yesterday because she was afraid of ridicule.

Miss Lutze yesterday contacted the Flying Saucer Investigation Committee.

She said she saw the "saucers" while driving along the Ballarat Avenue of Honor, two miles from the city.

"The saucers seemed to dive straight at the car and then turned upwards and disappeared," Miss Lutze said.

"They travelled slowly enough for me to count 28 and there were at least two more. They were not in formation, but were scattered, like a flock of birds.

"Their silver-white color made them a beautiful sight against the clear afternoon sky."

The superintendent of air traffic in Melbourne for the Department of Civil Aviation (Mr. R. M. Seymour) yesterday appealed for reports about strange objects in the sky.
