

Two More Flying Saucers Reported

Melbourne: A few hours after the Royal Australian Air Force disclosed yesterday that it was treating flying saucer reports 'very seriously' two strange objects were seen in the sky.

Mr. W. Allen, of Malvern, saw a flying saucer 20 to 30ft. in diameter at 1 p.m.

Mr. Allen said: "It was a shining object, moving much faster than any aircraft, and gave out a red vapor as it headed toward the bay about 2000ft. in the air.

He added: "I laughed at flying saucer reports, but it's different when you see one."

Mr. Mark Wallace, of Maryborough, and his two teenage children, saw a vivid orange light, the size and shape of a new moon in the southern sky at 10.50 p.m.

The light became a circle before it disappeared in the west, he said. It was low in

west, he said. It was low in the sky and was visible for four minutes.

In Melbourne yesterday, a high-ranking R.A.A.F. officer revealed that the air force had been

thoroughly investigating flying saucer reports since 1947.

"A few hundred reports were on the files," he said.
