## Victorian Air Objects

### TWO PUZZLING SIGHTS

Melbourne, January 9.

Two strange objects were noticed in Victorian skies during the night. Mr. W. Allen saw a "flying saucer" twenty to thirty feet in diameter at 1 a.m. "It was a shining object, moving much faster than any aircraft and gave out a red vapor as it flashed towards the bay about 2,000 feet up in the air," he remarked.

Mr. Mark Wallace and his two teen-age children saw a vivid orange light—the size and shape of a new moon—in the southern sky at 10.50 p.m. The light became a circle before it disappeared in the west. It was low in the sky and visible for four minutes.
