

'SAUCER' SEEN OVER SALE AND ADELAIDE

TWO "flying saucer" reports, which could have been of the same object, were reported in the weekend.

One report came from Sale, the other from Adelaide.

Late on Friday night Robert Cobain saw a "strange object" low on the horizon north-north-east of Sale.

Cobain said the object appeared to be corrugated across the top, and flashed crimson lights.

He said he called some neighbors in case his story was doubted.

While they watched the object the lights seemed to change from crimson to misty green, and it moved up and down.

Cobain said the object flashed crimson again, then disappeared.

"Hovered"

In Adelaide Mr. D. M. Scherek, a former airman, reported having seen a "yellowish-white object shading to deep orange" between 2.30 and 3.15 a.m. on Saturday.

It hovered, then swiftly moved vertically and sideways.

Mr. Scherek said he rang Professor Huxley, head of the Adelaide University physics department.

Mrs. Huxley answered the phone and saw the object, but did not awaken her husband, he said.

"But the swift sideways movement seen would not be shown by Jupiter unless there were some extraordinary refraction of light by the atmosphere."
