

Martians?

AFTER 18 months' investigation into the origin of flying saucers, the Australian Flying Saucer Bureau accepts the thesis that these originate in another planet.

Material being investigated by various research bodies already points strongly to the planet Mars being connected with them.

Unprecedented waves of the sightings of "unidentified" aerial objects occurred all over the world in 1950 and 1952 (when Mars was last at its closest point to the Earth). Record numbers of similar reports are expected this year and in 1956, when Martian approaches will again occur.

This view has already been confirmed by various U.S. researchers as was the Australian Bureau's prediction made last January and again

in July, that 1953 would be a "light year" for reports.
