

A FLYING TAMBOURINE LATEST SAUCER SIGHT

A flying tambourine is the latest shape in flying saucer sightings over SA.

It was reported by a Henley Beach man who described it as "a lovely sight."

He said he had seen it about 2.10 a.m. yesterday week. He had not reported it earlier as he feared the ridicule of his friends.

He would give his name and address for forwarding to the Flying Saucer Investigation Committee.

He said: "From the front verandah of my house in Seaview road, Henley Beach, it appeared to be about 2 ft. in diameter, was round like a plate, and was spinning.

"I got the impression of shallow depth like a tambourine, because I could see the skyline slightly above its edges.

"All round its circumference were lights, equally spaced, spinning with the whole. Although the ob-

ject was travelling quite fast it revolved comparatively slowly.

"The lights were yellowish, as one might see shining from a house window.

"It was travelling in a straight line from north to south, east of Seaview road, somewhere in the vicinity of Military road, Henley Beach.

"I saw it at an angle of about 30 to 45 deg. to my line of sight. I estimate its height at between 200 and 500 feet. It was revolving in a clockwise direction.

"It was low enough to be shielded from my vision by the houses on each side. I thus saw it for only a few seconds and had not time to call anyone."
