

UNKNOWN MAN'S SAUCER PICTURE

DARWIN, Saturday: A picture which an anonymous photographer claims is a flying saucer was published in the Alice Springs *Centralian Advocate* today.

The editor, Mr. Jim Bowditch, said the picture and an accompanying note were found under his office door a few days ago.

The note read: "For several reasons, one of which is that I can hardly believe it myself,

I refuse to come forward to allow my name to be used, but study this picture of the flying saucer yourself.

"I was taking pictures of Mount Gillen, overlooking the town, on January 15, the day a

The photograph shows Mount Gillen in the background, with a large object in the sky between the photographer and the mountain.

Many Alice Springs people believe it is genuine, but others say it could be anything from a button to a washing machine.

The object is circular, has a circle in the centre, and six heavy veins running to the outside rim.

number of Alice Springs people said they heard something strange pass over the town.

"Suddenly, an enormous round-looking object appeared from behind Mount Gillen.

"It went high, then dropped to come quite low between Mount Gillen and the town.

"It was not travelling fast at this stage, and I took the picture."
