

Flying Saucer Reported At Largs Bay

A strange illuminated object in the sky over Largs Bay was reported last night by several groups of observers.

Mr. J. L. Samuels, of Peterhead, said that he and a group of nine saw it from the home of a relative at Grosser street, Largs Bay.

The object, about two feet in diameter and emitting a yellow glow, was in sight for about 20 minutes, appearing and disappearing among the clouds. At times it moved swiftly, sometimes in circles, and gave off a loud crackling sound with a swishing effect as it darted about.

About 10.45 p.m. a bright light such as might be associated with a meteorite, shot across the sky from the vicinity. After that the object disappeared and the noise ceased.

Mr. E. F. Wilcocks, of Gilles Plains, said that with a group of friends he saw the object while at Largs Bay, having it under view for about 25 minutes. It was "at least at cloud height and moved fast."

A woman resident of Largs Bay said that the object was high in the sky, sometimes close to the zenith. After about 20 minutes it seemed to fall earthward and disappear. While moving fast, it gave off a noise like that of a rocket.

Another Largs Bay resident who saw the object said that the noise resembled that of a model plane.
