

# Strange Aircraft Over "The Alice"

**ALICE SPRINGS.**  
Thursday. — Three Alice Springs residents said to-day that a strange aircraft "streaked over the town" at 4.30 yesterday morning.

They are Mr. Eric Knight, businessman and returned soldier, his wife, and Mrs. G. Schmidt.

Mr. Knight said that he was lying awake when he heard what he thought was a jet plane roar overhead, apparently at terrific speed.

He thought no more of the incident until he found that no jet plane was in the area at the time.

Heaslip and five other Alice Springs people reported having seen and heard a strange aircraft.

He said to-day that the sound which Mr. Knight described was exactly the same as he heard.

The Alice Springs newspaper, the Centralian Advocate, recently published a photograph of a "flying saucer over Alice" which it received from an unidentified correspondent.
