

LATEST PLANE IN WOOMERA TESTS

ADELAIDE, Friday.

A special plane, believed to be the cause of many flying saucer reports, is being used in South Australia for experimental night flights connected with work at Woomera rocket range.

The plane, an Armstrong-Whitworth NF-11 Meteor, is stationed at Mallara R.A.A.F. Station. It has caused considerable discussion with its high speed and great flying heights.

The plane is one of the top-performance weapons in the N.A.T.O. defence system in Western Europe.
