

Saucer again

DARWIN, Thursday. —An Alice Springs native who never previously heard of a flying saucer has told his employer he was almost "skittled" recently by a strange object while he was riding a horse.

The native, named Sonny, told Mr. Arthur Pope, owner of Todd River Downs Station, 100 miles south of Alice Springs, that he was riding a horse over a low ridge when he saw a strange object 35 to 40 feet long "like a round ball with a tail."

"After it almost skittled me," said Sonny, "the thing lifted sharply, causing a heavy wind."
