

ANOTHER FLYING SAUCER REPORTED

Another sighting of "Flying Saucers" was reported in Dubbo on Saturday morning.

Mrs. N. Priddle of the Housing Commission flats, Church Street said that she saw a "round glowing shape" in the sky over the flats about 5 am Saturday.

My attention was drawn by a noise above the flats which sounded like a light plane with engine trouble.

"I looked out of the window and saw an oval shape speeding to the North-West and seeming to lose altitude. It left a glowing trail behind it like the afterglow of a flare.

"It travelled at a high speed and the flats blocked my view, by the time I had gone to another window it had disappeared," she said.

Mrs. Priddle, who lived at Narromine when the RAAF flying school was there, said that the sound of the engine was similar to that of a Tiger Moth with motor cut approaching for a landing.

At first she thought that a plane had dropped an emergency flare, but then realised that the glowing trail which it left was not the same color.

The Flying Saucer was about the same height as that of the civilian airliners approaching Dubbo to land, Mrs. Priddle added.
