

Train crew see "flying saucer"

MELBOURNE.—The crew of a Geelong-Ararat goods train are convinced that they saw a "flying saucer" at 7.20 a.m. yesterday. "We made no mistake about this saucer. The country here is as flat as a board," driver Ernie Smith said later.

Smith and his fireman, Colin Beacon, were between Duverney and Berrybank when they saw a dark purple object diving and banking in the eastern sky about four miles away. "It was round," Mr. Smith said. "It seemed to stop for about a minute and a half then dive at enormous speed."
