

Flying Saucer Seen In Vic.

MELBOURNE.—The crew of the 6 a.m. Geelong-Ararat goods train are convinced they saw a flying saucer at 7.20 a.m. yesterday.

WE made no mistake about this saucer. The country here is as flat as a board," Driver Ernie Smith said later.

Smith and his fireman, Colin Beacon, were between Duverney and Berry-

bank when they saw a dark purple object diving and banking in the eastern sky about four miles away.

"It was round," Ernie said. "It seemed to stop still for about a minute and a half, then dive at enormous speed."

Smith and Beacon said they watched the object for about four minutes before it disappeared behind a bank of trees, during which time their goods train had slowed
