

"Saucers" taken seriously

WASHINGTON, Sun.—The best brains in America are working on the "flying saucer" problem.

General Nathan F. Twining said this yesterday.

General Twining is the United States Air Force Chief of Staff.

He said 90 per cent. of "flying - saucer" reports

were pure imagination.

"But the Air Force could not explain the other reports.

General Twining said "some very reliable persons" had reported objects which could not be identified.

He added: "We are not discounting all these reports."

So far no facts had been found to show there was "anything to" the reports he said.
