

'SAUCER' OVER BAY?

Another eye-witness today reported having seen a "flying saucer" over Moreton Bay on Saturday night.

He is James Cawley, of Fernberg Road, Rosalie, who was fishing at Jumpinpin when he saw the strange object between 11 p.m. and midnight.

He said today that it appeared to be a wingless plane and was brightly lit as if by fluorescent lights.

Mr. Cawley said he and a companion watched the craft moving at high speed for about a minute.

Evidence has come from Tewantin that holidaymakers claimed, well

before they saw any report in the newspapers, that they had seen strange objects in the sky on Saturday night.

about midnight on Saturday.

They had been attending a scout dance at the Oddfellows' Hall and were walking home along Maryland Street, Stanthorpe's main street, when they saw what appeared to be a round object flying from north to south in the brilliant moonlight.

The object shone and was travelling at a great speed. It had a big red light and another light was shining across the sky. The object kept about the same height and soon disappeared from view.
