

R.A.A.F. To Investigate "Saucers"

MELBOURNE, Wednesday.
—Reports of a "flying saucer" having been seen on Saturday night at Roma, 318 miles west of Brisbane, will be investigated by the R.A.A.F.

Several people reported having seen the mysterious object, which they said hurtled across the sky at hundreds of miles an hour at a height of only 100 to 200 feet.

One witness described the object as yellow, the size of a car, and noiseless. Another said the object appeared V-shaped and had what seemed to be two red rear lights.

A R.A.A.F. spokesman said **today applied for discharge** a "flying saucer" file, and records of sightings, in the hope that depth of evidence and thorough analysis would solve a world-wide mystery.

Intelligence officers in Queensland are checking the Roma reports against known aircraft movements, and will contact witnesses who saw the object.
