

"Saucer" Seen At Bundaberg

BUNDABERG, May 20.— People in Bundaberg and district to-day reported seeing or hearing a strange object which they believe may have been a "flying saucer."

At approximately 11.45 p.m., one Bundaberg woman and several Gin Gin residents claimed that they heard a peculiar noise overhead, which attracted their attention.

A South Bundaberg woman said her attention was attracted by a strange rumbling noise while she was in her back yard. The noise was quite different from that of the engine of an aeroplane. At a very high altitude in the north-west, she observed a circular silver object.

It appeared to be gaining height at a terrific speed, until it eventually disappeared from her sight.

A long, single trail of vapour appeared to be trailing behind it. About the same time several Gin Gin residents were attracted by a peculiar noise and ran outside their houses to investigate it.

However, on glancing skywards they were not able to see anything.

Mr. B. Honor said that the noise was a definite rumble and appeared to come from the coast and disappear in the south-west. He said the noise could be heard for about two minutes. It was travelling at a terrific speed. It sounded like some missile across the sky.
