

Flying Saucer Had Three Tails

A "flying saucer" seen between Bollon and Morven on Saturday night was of the usual circular type but with three tails of bright fire.

This saucer was seen by Mr. V. M. Hallinan, owner of Arjuna Station, Hughenden, who was returning from inspecting his sheep near Hebel, on the border.

It was about 11.15 p.m. when he was opening a gate about 10 miles South of Morven that he saw the "thing" in the sky. It travelled from North to South at a terrific speed, and then suddenly appeared to black out. There were no noises associated with the phenomenon so far as Mr. Hallinan could hear.

Describing the sight to the "Leader" on Monday morning, Mr. Hallinan said that the main body of the "saucer" was circular, with a ring of bright flame or fire, and the three tails extended from the rear of the travelling matter—one from each outer edge and one from the rear centre. He drew a sketch of the apparition for the "Leader."

When he was obtaining petrol at Augathella next morning he asked the man by whom he was being served had he seen it. This man said that he had not, but his wife had, just as they returned home from the pictures on the previous night. She called her

previous night. She called her husband to look at it, but before he got outside the house, the "saucer" had blacked out.

Mr. Hallinan has always treated reports of "flying saucers" with the average distrust and caution, but now that he has seen one, he is as convinced as any of the others who have reported seeing them, that there is something definite and stable in the phenomenon.

Before purchasing Arjuna about 10 months ago, Mr. Hallinan was residing at 27 Camira St., Maroubra, Sydney. He continued his way to Arjuna on Monday afternoon.
