

THIS "FLYING SAUCER" WAS IDENTIFIED

BRISBANE, Fri.—Crowds of people, in an area of Southern Queensland, covering 12,000 square miles, today watched an Air Force Mustang, piloted by 19-year-old Colin Ackland, of Townsville, undergoing high altitude tests six miles up.

The tests, conducted within a limited flying range, could be seen by people in towns as far apart as Caloundra, Toowoomba and Murwillumbah.

While the Mustang was manoeuvring, country newspaper offices were besieged with telephone calls from watchers who thought the plane was a flying

saucer.

Air Force Station at Archerfield had more than 400 phone inquiries, and 150 more people rang Amberley station.
