

"FLYING SAUCER" SIGHTINGS

**FALL OFF IN U.S. SINCE
1952.**

WASHINGTON, June 1
(A.A.P.)—Air Force officials said to-day that reports of "flying saucers" had fallen off swiftly since 1952.

They believed more scientific investigating and better public education were responsible.

So far this year, only 87 "sightings" had been reported, but the "flying saucer season"—this coincided with the July-August meteor showers—was just coming in. Reports of "flying saucers" increased when meteors were most common.

The Air Force said it still was unable to explain about 10 per cent. of the sightings.
