

# Flying Saucer Reports Fall Off

WASHINGTON, June 1—Air Force officials said today that reports of “flying saucers” had fallen off swiftly since 1952. They believed that more scientific investigating and better public education were responsible.

So far this year, only 87 “sightings” had been reported. But the “flying saucer season”—this coincided with the July-August meteor showers—was just coming in. Reports of “flying saucers” increased when meteors were most common.

The Air Force said it was still unable to explain about 10 per cent of the sightings.
