## **Rush of Reports in Sydney**

### **FLYING SAUCERS IN ALL SUBURBS**

Sydney, June 15.—Sydney is getting a rush of flying saucer reports.

Last night and early to-day scores of people living in different suburbs reported having seen "things" in the sky.

The Weather Bureau says that they were not a natural phenomenon.

The Government Meteorologist, Mr. K. McKinnon, saw "a light about 2000 ft. up that hovered for several minutes."

Mr. Jim Fawcett, manager of a flying school at Illiwarra, reported having seen a light "about 3000 ft. up, bigger and brighter than any star."

Others said that the light frequently changed colour.

Later people said that they saw a long, blue object. Shooting blue flame, flying over Sydney this morning.

Mr. William Mitchell of Little Bay, said that it looked like a railway carriage and was about 600 ft. up.

Miss Amy Phillips, of Maroubra, described it as 30 ft.
