

"SAUCER" DETAILS IF ANY, WANTED

SYDNEY, June 16.—The Federal Government should tell the public if it were conducting "flying saucer" experiments with new weapons, the leader of the Methodist Mission to the Nation, Rev. Alan Walker, said to-day.

He said that public scares about the "flying saucers" would be killed and much anxiety eased if the Government would release some details without violating security.

"It seems that greater information should be given to the people to-day about what is happening in scientific experiments," he said.

"I personally don't believe in 'flying saucers.' My impression is that 'flying saucers' are a projection of the fears, emotions and doubts of this peculiar age in which we live. But there is so much happening in scientific circles that the people do not know about. There may be experiments going on which could account for these unexplained happenings."
