

SAUCER LOOPED THE LOOP THIS TIME

MURWILLUMBAH, Sunday.—Six Tweed residents at Crystal Creek tonight watched a flying saucer for 15 minutes as it "streaked in various directions, returning each time to hover over the same place before finally disappearing."

One of the people, Mr. Ray Curnow, described the mystery as a "monster X compared with the biggest star in the sky." He said he was with five other persons at Crystal Creek when the "saucer" was first sighted south west from them at 8.15 p.m. It was then hovering over a nearby hill.

During the next 15 minutes the "saucer" moved off to the east, returned and went to the west, returned and hovered and then "went in various directions, each time returning and hovering over the same area."

Watched steadily

He said the object finally "looped the loop, then lost intensity and disappeared."

the rest of the group watched**

the object continuously for 15 minutes before it disappeared. He said it appeared to be about five times larger in diameter than the biggest star in the sky and about four or five miles away.

The object was like "a bright light or bright star which changed colour and glittered like a cut diamond."
