

# 'Flying lights' are still with us

They are still seeing lights in the sky in Melbourne and Sydney.

## In Melbourne:

Mr. Patrick Fitzpatrick, 29, a communications technician, of Rattray st., Montmorency, near Eltham, said a giant spherical object moved across the sky at fantastic speed about 6.30 p.m. yesterday.

"It spun about in large circles for about 10 minutes at 8,000 feet," said Mr. Fitzpatrick. "It moved straight upwards and then sideways, and it seemed to be able to move in any direction," he said.

"There was a red glow from underneath it," he added.

Mr. Fitzpatrick said it left a trail of white light, and was spinning all the time; eventually it disappeared high in the sky.

## In Sydney:

Hugh Burgoyne, of Eve st., South Strathfield, said he and his family saw a

and his family saw a "strange light" in the sky near Bankstown yesterday morning.

"It was like a big globe suspended in the sky," he said.

Mr. Burgoyne said he and his family had seen the light at 6.40 a.m. from the back step of their home.

It sank out of sight after 35 minutes.
