

## A Motor Party Sees "Saucer" Over Desert

KALGOORLIE, Mon.—Three east-west motorists saw what they believed to be a flying-saucer north-west of Eucla over the Nullarbor Plain shortly after 8 o'clock on Sunday night.

They are Mr. T. A. Mulhearn and his wife and their 23-year-old son, Paul, of Sydney.

Mr. Paul Mulhearn called the attention of his parents to the object and they watched it for 15 minutes as it manoeuvred around the sky, "obviously under control." It disappeared suddenly.

Mr. Mulhearn said tonight that the object appeared as a brilliant white light against a background of dark storm clouds and appeared to have, at each side, a fin or elevator which moved up and down. The object was about five miles distant at an altitude of no more than 1,000ft.

Another party of overland motorists reported having seen a similar object over the sea about 7.30 p.m. on Sunday.
